Nigeria Aviation is currently embarking on extensive air transport infrastructural development with the remodeling and expansion of existing Federal Airports to increase in capacity to handle more passengers. It is expected that all the 22 airports of the Federal Airports Authority of Nigeria (FFAN) would have received a complete face lift by year 2015 complemented by brand new airports that are being developed in various States of the Federation such as Akwa-Ibom,

Delta, Bauchi, Jegawa.

The economic transformation agenda of the Nigerian President Goodluck Jonathan has Aviation as key priority to drive its success and also as an instrument for sustaining the Nigerian economic leadership position in Africa. Nigeria has an attractive market base of 170 million populations and a GDP estimated at US\$ 502 billion with a growing middle class travel market.

Air travel demand in Nigeria is growing very fast for domestic, regional and international routes. By 2015 more airlines will seek to increase their operations in Nigeria using it as a hub for the regional markets of West and central Africa. Total number of domestic and international passengers are expected to have grown beyond 16 million per year compared to 14.3 million in 2012.

Construction of new international terminals at Nigeria's four hub airports, Lagos, Abuja, Kano and Port Harcourt airports was approved by Government in Sep-2012 and hopefully will be ready by 2015. The projects are being developed by the China Civil Engineering Construction Corporation (CCECC) with loan funding from the China Nexim Bank of USD500 million, under a

21-year build operate and transfer (B-O-T) agreement with the Chinese government.

The airport industry is therefore challenged now more that ever before to keep track and focus so as to justify the ongoing financial attention it is currently receiving. **Airport Business Summit** is designed to offer the platform to help operatives and allied businesses to discuss on further development, sustainability options and how increase the fortunes of airport operations and still maintain high quality of service delivery.
